Friendship Baptist Church is in Lawrence County, and the cemetery straddles the county line. The newer sections of the cemetery are in Lawrence County, while the oldest sections are in Morgan County.

**Directions:** From Danville, go south on County Road 41 (S. Danville Road) 3.6 mi, crossing Alabama Highway 157 and continuing south. Turn right on Friendship Road (you will see a sign for Friendship Baptist Church). Go 0.6 mi and you will have reached the church and cemetery. NE ¼ of NE ¼, Section 12, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, and W ½ of NW ¼, Section 7, Township 8 South, Range 5 West.

## A Note on Abbreviations

I have followed the format, style, and conventions of Marine and Walls' 1983 enumeration of the cemetery from *Morgan County Cemeteries*, Volume II. "SS" denotes names of occupants buried together under the same headstone. "FS" is a footstone bearing an inscription, including veterans' markers. "HS" is a common headstone with no individual names, usually with foot markers for each person buried at the headstone. "FHM" is a temporary funeral home marker. Underlining denotes an uncertain, difficult-to-read inscription. My annotations that fall outside a simple description of the cemetery are given in blue.

Sections are my own definitions, and are not always completely clear looking at the cemetery. See the description of sections at <http://www.zdutton.org/cemetery/friendship/>.
